Automotive Detailing 1

A 16-week+ course that prepares job seekers with disabilities for entry-level automotive detailing jobs. Automotive Detailing is offered in partnership with the Community College of Baltimore County at the DORS Workforce & Technology Center campus in Baltimore.

TRAINING INCLUDES:

- Customer service
- Interior & exterior cleaning techniques
- Proper use of equipment, including solutions mixing and orbital polisher
- Shop safety

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS:

- Ability to lift 50 pounds
- Ability to squat, stoop and kneel
- Certain criminal backgrounds may disqualify an individual from program
- Valid driver's license with no more than two points

Auto Detailing 2

An advanced 8-week training for students who successfully complete **AUTO DETAILING 1** and demonstrate the following:

- Ability to learn advanced techniques and equipment use
- Quality hands-on work required by high-end detail shops or dealerships
- 3rd grade or higher reading comprehension level

ADDITIONAL TRAINING INCLUDES:

- Use of clay bar and wet sanding
- Removing minor defects and scratches
- Compounding and use of multispeed buffer
