

Childcare Training

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A 16-week course that prepares job seekers with disabilities for a certification that can lead to employment as Childcare Providers. This training is offered in partnership with the Community College of Baltimore County and includes classroom instruction at the DORS Workforce & Technology Center (WTC) campus in Baltimore and a nine-week internship experience at an approved and licensed childcare facility at select locations throughout the state.

TRAINING INCLUDES:

- Childcare for the school-age child
- · Communication skills for childcare
- First Aid & CPR certification
- Group care of infants and toddlers
- Growth and development of children
- How to organize and manage activities for young children
- A community-based internship

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS:

- At least 18 years of age
- 6th-grade reading comprehension and 4th-grade math skills
- High school diploma, GED®, or certificate
- Ability to lift and move children up to 50 pounds or more
- Ability to see details at close range
- Ability to hear and give verbal instructions, in noisy conditions
- Ability to change from one task to another
- Background check and health clearance
- Basic computer knowledge
- Ability to supervise children independently
