EMPLOYMENT SERVICES

DORS WTC Deaf/Hard of Hearing (D/HH) Employment Services partner with job seekers who are Deaf or hard of hearing to help them prepare for, find, and keep stable employment. Staff also encourage job seekers towards self-advocacy and independence.

The D/HH Employment Services staff are fluent in American Sign Language (ASL). D/HH services are offered at the WTC and virtually.

Employment Assistance Includes:

- Resume building
- Cover letter writing
- Job-seeking skills training
- Interview practice
- Job application
- Job developers
- Job coaching
- Interpreting at the job interview, orientation, training, etc.
- On-the-job training with employers

DRIVER EDUCATION

- WTC offers Driver Education for DORS consumers who use ASL as their primary communication by providing ASL interpreting services.
- Tutoring sessions for Driver Education class may also be available.
