Warehouse Technician Training

An 8-week course that prepares job seekers with disabilities for jobs in a modern warehouse, taught in partnership with the Community College of Baltimore County (CCBC).

TRAINING INCLUDES:

- Equipment handling
- Forklift safety certification
- Material storage
- Occupational safety & health
- Administration (OSHA) standards
- Preparing goods for shipment
- Receiving incoming stock
- Warehouse safety guidelines

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS:

- Basic computer literacy
- A clean background check or an ability to get bonded
- 3rd-grade math level and 4th-grade reading comprehension
- Ability to follow step-by-step directions
- Basic problem-solving and observation skills
- Ability to lift 50 pounds
- Ability to tolerate varied workplace temperatures
- Ability to stand for long periods of time
- Ability to do simple multiplication and division
- Access to private transportation is strongly recommended as most warehouses are not on public transportation
