# *Office for Blindness & Vision Services*



## **What**

The **Office for Blindness & Vision Services (OBVS)** oversees programs and services for individuals whose primary disability is vision loss. It is a program of the Maryland State Department of Education's Division of Rehabilitation Services (DORS).

## **Who**

OBVS includes rehabilitation counselors, rehabilitation technologists, case managers and rehabilitation teachers with specialized training in issues of importance to people who are blind, vision impaired or deaf-blind. They assist people in designing and carrying out plans for employment. OBVS can also assist individuals over age 55 who have independent living goals.

Programs and services include career guidance and assessment, assistive technology, vocational or academic education, independent living skills training, orientation and mobility and job placement.

OBVS also administers the **Maryland Business Enterprise Program for the Blind**, which prepares individuals to operate successful retail concession and food service operations in public facilities.

## **Why**

DORS is committed to the employment and independent living for Marylanders who are blind or vision impaired.

## Where

DORS counselors, case managers and teachers are located in DORS offices throughout Maryland. Individuals referred for DORS services will be assigned a counselor or teacher who works in his or her community. OBVS has staff at the Workforce & Technology Center, a DORS rehabilitation facility in northeast Baltimore, where there is also extensive programming for individuals who are blind or have vision impairments.

**DORS Works!** Personal income was the primary source of support for only 10.9% when first applying for DORS services. At closure, 75.9% said it was their primary source of support. \*

Fifty-five **(55)** licensed managers in the Maryland Business Enterprise Program for the Blind (MBEPB) operate **71** vending facilities. Their average annual income is **\$45,453**.
