## Division of Rehabilitation Services OBVS Career-Life Planning Referral

A number of factors impact an individual's desire and ability to enter the workforce. This four-week program will help determine if working is right for the participant and will allow for guided self-assessment of skills, knowledge, abilities, strengths and weaknesses, and job readiness, as well as exploration of career choices. Through this discovery the participant will be able to determine his/her interest and commitment to achieving employment or alternate life goals and those steps necessary to achieve the desired path. The following checklist is a guide for counselors to determine areas that should be addressed in preparing to refer an individual to the OBVS Career-Life Planning program.

For each item, check off if the individual demonstrates ability in that area.
