- Proper care and maintenance of spray guns
- Proper masking of vehicle and parts
- Shop & personal safety
- Using proper equipment and materials
- Using a paint booth
- Work experience in the community

Program Requirements

- Ability to lift 50 pounds
- Ability to squat, stoop and kneel
- Certain criminal backgrounds may disqualify an individual from this program
- 8th-grade reading level
- Successful completion of Auto Detailing 1 & 2
- Valid driver's license with no more than two points
