



Child Care Training

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A 16-week course that prepares job seekers with disabilities for a certification that can lead to employment as Child Care Providers. This training is offered in partnership with the Community College of Baltimore County and includes classroom instruction and a nine-week internship experience at an approved and licensed child care facility at select locations throughout the state.

TRAINING INCLUDES:

- Growth and development of children
- Organizing and managing activities for young children
- Communication skills for child care
- Group care of infants and toddlers
- Child care for the school-age child
- First Aid and CPR certification
- Community-based internship

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS:

- At least 18 years of age
- Background check and health clearance
- 6th grade reading comprehension level and basic math skills
- High school diploma, GED®, or certificate
- Basic computer knowledge
- Ability to lift and move children up to 30 pounds or more
- Ability to see details at close range
- Ability to hear and give verbal instructions, in noisy conditions
- Ability to change from one task to another
- Ability to supervise children independently
