Within WTC, a Deaf & Hard-of-Hearing Specialist provides leadership and technical assistance in the implementation of programs and services for individuals who are Deaf and Hard-of-Hearing.

- Dedicated D/HH Center Counselors.
- Signing support staff in Residential Services and Security.
- Vocational Interpreters across all programs.
- Staff that are life-long students of ASL.
- Interns from Interpreter Prep and Deaf Studies programs.

### PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS:

### EMPLOYMENT OUTLOOK:
