DORM SERVICES

- Dormitory residents get three meals a day at the cafeteria.

- Supervised 24 hours a day by WTC staff and residential advisors.
- Medication monitoring.

People who attend WTC programs and stay in the dormitory must first be referred by their DORS counselor.
