This partnership with CVS Health® and the Community College of Baltimore County (CCBC) prepares job seekers with disabilities to take the national Pharmacy Technician Certifying Board (PTCB) test and become Certified Pharmacy Technicians.

Pharmacy Technicians assist pharmacists in hospitals or retail pharmacies, serving customers, processing insurance claims, maintaining inventory and filling prescriptions.

TRAINING INCLUDES:

- 14 weeks of classroom instruction
- 6 weeks of clinical on-the-job training
- Training in CVS programs and procedures, inventory management, prescription medication measurements

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS:

- Be 18 years of age and possess a HS Diploma or GED.
- Have the desire to work in a retail environment and the ability to provide excellent customer service to the public.
- Have a 9th-grade reading comprehension level and 9th-grade math skills.
- Be detail oriented, be able to change from one task to another, and work accurately and guickly.
- Have efficient computer, telephone, and study skills.
- Pass a drug screen and background check prior to the start of the program.
- Be able to lift up to 30 pounds and bend, stoop, stand for long periods of time.
- Have close visual acuity.
- Have a COVID-19 vaccination.
