Virtual College Autism Mentoring Program (VCAMP)

The Virtual College Autism Mentoring Program (VCAMP) is a mentoring and support service for students on the Autism spectrum who attend college but can't participate in the in-person DORS Pathways program. VCAMP is completely online and available to students attending either a two-year or four-year college in Maryland or out of state.

VCAMP helps students navigate college. It also focuses on helping the student develop selfadvocacy and social skills in order to be successful in the college environment.

VCAMP STUDENTS LEARN:

- · How to successfully transition from high school to college
- · How to successfully go from a two-year to a four-year college
- About supports available on their college campus, such as Disability Support Services (DSS) and academic tutoring
- Time management & organizational skills
- Self-advocacy & social skills
- Appropriate grooming & hygiene skills
- · Other skills needed to successfully navigate the college environment

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS:

- Be a DORS participant on the Autism spectrum.
- Have an approved Individualized Plan for Employment (IEP) that includes college.
- Work towards an industry-recognized college degree or certification from a two-year or four-year college where the in-person DORS Pathways program is not available.
- Meet with DORS Autism Services staff for weekly online sessions.
- Attend weekly VCAMP online group sessions.
