
# **Childcare Training**

## **TRAINING INCLUDES**

The program includes classroom instruction and a 9-week internship experience at an approved and licensed childcare facility in the community.

- Childcare for the school-age child
- Communication skills for childcare
- First Aid & CPR certification
- Group care of infants and toddlers
- Growth and development of children
- How to organize and manage activities for young children

## **PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS**

#### **ABILITY TO:**

- Change from one task to another
- Hear and give verbal instructions in noisy conditions
- Lift/move children up to 50 pounds+
- Supervise children independently

#### BF:

At least 18 years of age

#### HAVE:

- Basic computer knowledge
- Background check & health clearance
- High school diploma, GED<sup>®</sup> or certificate
- 6th-grade reading comprehension & 4th-grade math skills
