- Disability accommodations are rights, not special help.
- **1.** Ask for what you need. Advocate for yourself.
- You are an important and valuable part of campus diversity.
- 2. Diversity includes disability.
- College disability services offices can be gatekeepers.
- 3 Most are good allies for students, but some are not. Demand professional, individualized, respectful services and file a complaint if you don't get them.
- Feed your soul and body.
- **4.** Balance your valuable time, energy, and health.
  - Stay focused on your career.
- $\mathbf{5}$ . If it won't help you get a job or maintain your passion for college, don't bother.
- Find a community.
- **6.** Never go it alone. Consider connecting with others who have disabilities.
- Universally design your own learning.
- **7.** Learn how you learn best, and then use your strengths and unique learning style.
  - Never apologize for your disability or your accommodations.
- **8.** If you apologize, people may think you are ashamed.
- Fight oppression and bullying in any form.
- 9. Ableism is just one "ism." If one of us is oppressed, all of us are oppressed.
- 10. Learn disability history.
