Project Overview

In 2023, UME <u>Marylanders Online</u> joined forces with <u>Maryland Accessible Telecommunications</u> (MAT) to address the unique digital equity challenges faced by individuals with low vision and blindness.

The collaboration led to the development of a virtual training series called "Talk Text and Train", a groundbreaking, multi-month project that saw the facilitation of 19 bi-weekly training sessions held between October 2023 and January 2024.

Program Outcomes

60 people attended the September 27th Kick-off day

An average of 30 people participated in all followup sessions

23 participants received certifications for completing the training series

Before the TTT series, only 51% of participants were familiar with the devices.

After completing the training, 85% of participants stated that they would be able to master the device with additional sessions.

TTT graduates are earning an average of \$65/hour




Figure 4: Graphics illustrating the survey results shared on previous slide.
